



## 2009-2010 Registration Information

### Tuition

Classes are either 1 or 1.5 hours. Classes will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays. Schedule subject to change. Classes will be held at DeSoto Ballroom 9121 Pigeon Roost, Olive Branch MS 38654.

Payments are in 9 monthly installments. There is a \$60.00 early registration fee/\$70.00 late registration per family. There will be a 10% late fee for any tuition received after the first of the month and a \$25.00 fee for checks with insufficient funds. Payments are non-refundable. Class schedule will follow the LIFE class calendar. **Classes must have a 4 student minimum.**

### Class Attire

Proper attire is required for each class. Hair must be secured in a bun. Jewelry and loose clothing should not be worn in class. Female students - black leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet slippers (ballet), Male students - white t-shirt, black tights, white socks and white ballet shoes or jazz shoes. Workout attire for the Strengthening & Toning Class.

### Attendance

In order for the class to be conducted, a minimum of three students must be in attendance. Makeup classes are not currently available. Good behavior is expected of each student. Artist-In-Residence program reserves the right to dismiss any student who is disruptive to class.

### Background

Michele LaMachio has 38 years experience in performing and teaching classical dance. She is a graduate of the North Carolina School of the Arts and studied at the School of American Ballet in New York City. She danced professionally in a soloist position for the U.S. Terpsichore Dance Company and Latin American Dance Theater located in New York City. In North Carolina, she danced with the North Carolina Dance Theater, the University of North Carolina at Greensboro Dance Company and the Dancer's Repertory Ensemble as a principal. She has taught at numerous dance studios and also for the City of Greensboro, NC. She has been a guest teacher for the Wake Forest University Dance Workshop and principal dancer for the televised opening of the Lawrence Joel Coliseum. Presently, she is the Executive Director of the Lighthouse Instruction For Enrichment Program and Owner/Director of the Artist-In-Residence Fine Arts Program.
