Lighthouse Instruction for Enrichment (LIFE) is a regional learning center that offers unique educational and social opportunities for home-educated students in grades K-12. Our mission is to provide academically enriching courses in a Christlike, supportive atmosphere. We are staffed by parents, volunteers, and mission-oriented teachers to meet the needs of the local homeschool community. Recognizing that parents are the primary educators of their children, LIFE cannot take your place, but we do provide students with educational opportunities, as well as teacher and peer relationships, in a relaxed classroom atmosphere. We utilize experienced teachers who are well versed in accommodating each type of learning style. Parents are always welcome to observe or volunteer during the program.

- **Classes** are offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 8:30am to 3:15pm. You may register for as many or few classes and days as you choose, but be informed that currently we do not have a supervised study hall for open time slots. Lunch hour is supervised, however.
- **Assembly** is held from 2:00pm - 2:15pm on Tuesdays. The Assembly schedule will include the Pledge of Allegiance, weekly announcements/handouts, closing prayer and "Showman." Showman is an opportunity for your child to learn the valuable life skill of public speaking or presentation in front of a positive and supportive group. Examples of showmanship are playing an instrument, reciting a poem, displaying and explaining artwork, etc.
- **Grades** and syllabuses are accessed via an online gradebook program. Semester grades are compiled in January and May. Grades are based on class work, homework, class participation, and tests. Students who take classes in grades 9-12 can receive high school credit for classes completed. There are some honors level classes available. Parents are responsible for assigning course credit on the student's transcript.
- **A Curriculum list** will be provided when your student's class schedule is confirmed. Parents are responsible for curriculum purchase unless otherwise indicated.

LIFE is now accepting applications for the 2010-2011 school year. The LIFE year begins 8/10/10 and ends on 5/12/11. Please check our website at www.life4enrichment.org for LIFE courses, schedules, fees, etc.

- Early registration is from May 1 - June 1, with a \$75 fee per family. Registration after June 2nd will incur an additional \$25 fee. Classes will be finalized as soon as the minimum enrollment is filled. You will be contacted (and reimbursed) if a class is cancelled.
- There will be Open Houses throughout the registration period. Please check the website for dates. We will have a **Parent Orientation meeting**, on **Thursday, August 5 at 6:00pm**. Please check the website for updates.

CONDUCT

The following rules have been established at L.I.F.E. in order to maintain an academically, morally, and socially healthy atmosphere for your children. These guidelines are non-negotiable and will be enforced by both teachers and L.I.F.E. Directors.

1. Dress Code:

- Bottom of shirt and top of pants must overlap, even when bending over
- Shirt straps must be at least 2 inches wide
- No skintight pants or shirts
- Shirt should show no cleavage
- No offensive language/symbolism on T-shirts
- No mini skirts, Shorts must be of modest length

If there is a dispute, L.I.F.E. directors maintain the right to have the final say about appropriate dress. _____ (initial)

2. Homework Policy:

Homework should be completed as assigned. In general, L.I.F.E. encourages daily Foreign language practice across all grade levels. Late homework will incur a 10-point deduction for the first overdue week. If the homework is not turned in after the first late week, **a zero grade will be recorded.** Extenuating circumstances must be discussed with Teachers initially and Director as needed.

3. Behavior:

- No foul or borderline language allowed.
- No name-calling allowed.
- No hitting or other physical aggression allowed.
- Students are expected to show respect to teachers and other students.
- No public display of affection between boys and girls.
- No smoking any where on the campus.
- No electronic devices, CD players, scooters, roller blades, or skateboards are allowed.
- Students should turn off cell phones while they are in class. An emergency contact number is provided.
- L.I.F.E. staff reserves the right to address any other behaviors seen as disruptive or disrespectful.

4. Discipline Policy:

All students will be issued 3 merits at the beginning of the school year. Demerit reports will be issued at the Teachers and Directors discretion based on the conduct policies listed above. Any student with 2 merits or above at end of school year will be eligible to participate in a Pizza/Ice Cream Party.

- *Each demerit:* Demerit report issued by Teacher/Director (parent(s) copied). Possible classroom removal/TeacherStudent (Teacher removes student from class and discusses behavior with student.)
- *2nd demerit:* Director/Parent/Child Conference.
- *3rd demerit:* Dismissal from the program.

In extreme situations, the parent may be called following the first offense. L.I.F.E. Directors reserve the right to expel students that do not adhere to L.I.F.E. rules. No refund will be given for expelled students. _____ (Initial)
